#### *Pinecrest to host 4th Annual Relay for Life Saturday*

**Pinecrest, Fla.** – Cancer never sleeps and neither will Relay for Life participants during Pinecrest's fourth annual Relay For life event that kicks-off at 12:00 noon Saturday, March 1st and ends at 8:00 a.m. Sunday, March 2nd. The event will take place in Evelyn Greer Park, 8200 SW 124th Street.

This year the neighboring municipalities of Palmetto Bay and Cutler Bay will join Pinecrest to make for a huge event with over 40 teams and a \$200,000 donation goal. All the proceeds from the event will go to the American Cancer Society.

The theme for this year's event is World's Fair 2014. The Village team's theme is France and Pinecrest Mayor Cindy Lerner will lead the Youth Advisory Council with a Spain theme.

All cancer survivors will be honored and are welcome to attend. There will be a Survivors Tent where survivors can eat lunch and dinner. There will be complimentary massages and goodie bags provided. Luminaria bags and candles will be available the day of the event for a \$5 donation.

Each team will have a dedicated booth that will feature food from the country the team is representing, an activity and a fact board about a specific type of cancer. There will be a children's area with bounce houses and pony rides, and there will be bands performing throughout the day and evening.
