*Village Parks now have sunscreen spray stations to protect visitors from the sun's harmful UV rays*

**Pinecrest, Fla.** – It's a fact. Too much sun without adequate protection can result in skin cancer later in life. As part of a community health initiative, Pinecrest parks now have sunscreen spray stations to help visitors protect themselves from the sun's harmful ultra violet (UV) rays. The SPF 30 sunscreen also contains all natural citronella insect repellent.

Having sunscreen spray stations in the parks helps visitors remember that one should always keep sunscreen on hand while out in the sun. But if one forgets, sunscreen is available for \$1 at Evelyn Greer Park, Coral Pine Park and Suniland Park – with more locations coming soon.

The American Cancer Society recommends that one use sun screen and lip balm with broad spectrum protection and a sun protection factor (SPF) of 30 or higher. One can sunburn even on cloudy days and on average, children get three times more exposure than adults.

Pinecrest parks include Coral Pine Park, Evelyn Greer Park, Flagler Grove Park, Red Road Linear Park, Suniland Park and Veterans Wayside Park.
